Steps for Upgrading Wonderware Compact Panel from InTouch Compact Edition to InTouch Machine Edition

Introduction

This *Tech Note* applies to machines with Model Number: **CPCx-xxx-7xxxx**, manufactured by AIS.

Procedure

On the InTouch Machine Edition Development machine:

- Copy **C:\Program Files (x86)\Wonderware\InTouch Machine Edition v7.1\Redist\WinCE 5.0\ArmV4I\BIN\CEServer.exe** to a USB drive.

On the Wonderware Compact Panel:

1. Go to **My Device** on the WIN CE.
2. Create a folder called InTouch Machine Edition on the resident flash of the CE device.
3. Insert the USB drive with **CEserver.exe** on it.
4. Copy **CEServer.exe** from the USB drive to the folder you created in Step 2.
5. Go to Control Panel -> Auto Run Maker.
6. Ensure that the version number is **1.28**. If it is, proceed to Step 6. If not, [download AutoRunMaker](#) .

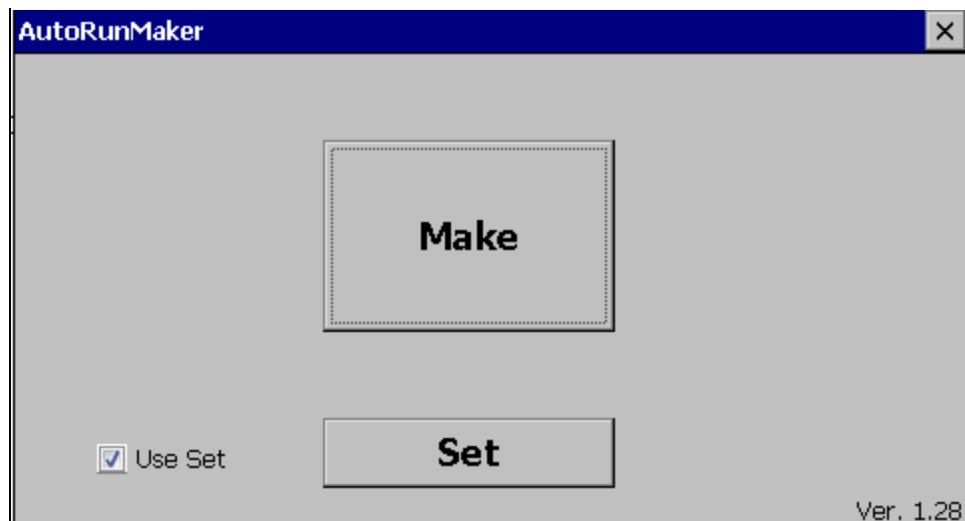


FIGURE 1: AUTO RUN MAKER

7. Select the **Use Set** check box and press the **SET** button.
8. On the Startup tab add the **CEserver.Exe** by pressing the + Button and selecting **CEServer** stored in **\ResidentFlash\InTouch Machine Edition** on the resident flash drive.
9. On the Startup tab add the **ITCMgr.Exe** by pressing the + Button and selecting **ITCMgr** stored in **\ResidentFlash\InTouchCompact** on the resident flash drive.
10. Remove ITCMgr.exe from the list by selecting it then pressing the - button.

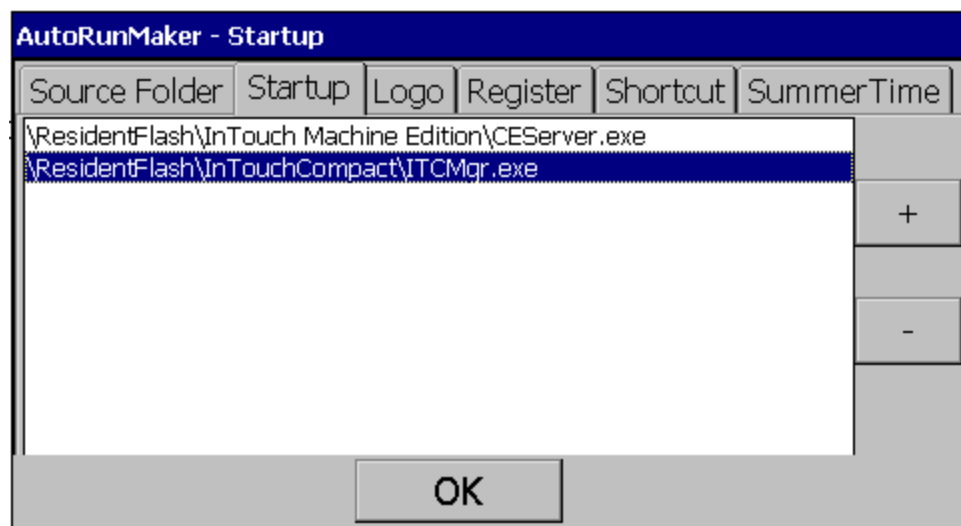


FIGURE 2: AUTO RUN MAKER - STARTUP

11. On the Shortcut tab add the **CEserver.exe** by pressing the + button.

12. On the Shortcut tab add the **ITCMgr.exe** by pressing the + button.
13. Remove ITCMgr by using the - button.

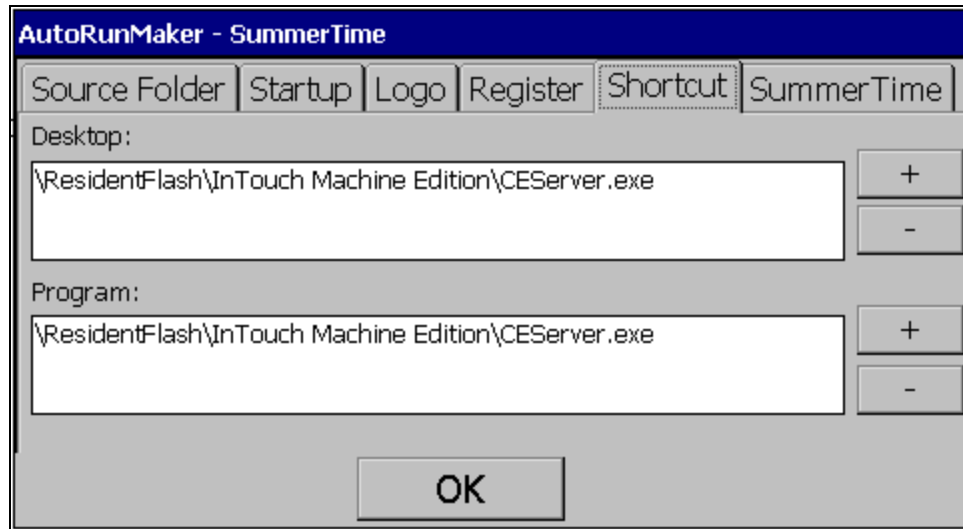


FIGURE 3: AUTO RUN MAKER - ITCMGR IS REMOVED

14. Press **OK**.
15. Press the **Make** button.

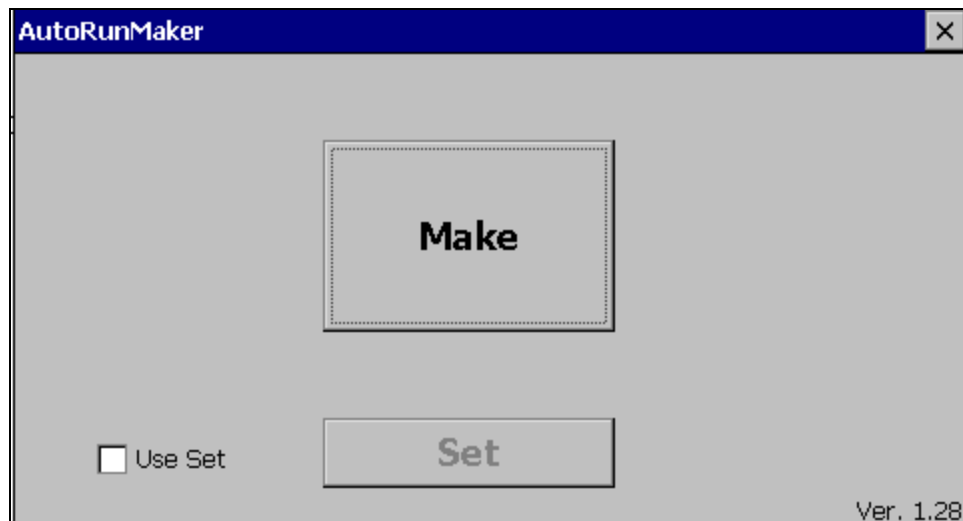


FIGURE 4: CLICK MAKE BUTTON

16. Press **OK** and restart the HMI.
