#### Introduction

Wonderware Historian Client (also known as HistClient, and formerly known as ActiveFactory) allows you to publish Microsoft Excel, Word, and Trend reports to the ActiveFactory Reporting Website (AFRWS).

If you experience any problem in publishing Historian Client reports to the AFRWS or to Wonderware Information Server (WIS), you should first try the recommendations in **Tech Note 694 Resolving Issues in Publishing ActiveFactory v9.2 Reports**.

However, if the issue still occurs, and you are using the Windows 2008 Operating System, you can use the recommendations in this tech note to resolve the issue.

- Microsoft SQL Server 2005 SP2 (or later)


### Acronyms

- HistClient: Historian Client Desktop version (Trend, Excel Workbook, Word Report)
- AFRWS: ActiveFactory Reporting Website
- WIS 4.0: Wonderware Information Server 4.0 (used interchangeably with AFRWS)
- AF Web Client: Machine using Internet browser to view published reports
- InSQL: Wonderware Historian version 9.0 or 10.0

## Troubleshooting Tips

Enable the Distributed COM (DCOM) option for the computers running HistClient desktop components and AFRWS (or WIS).

- 1. To check this, click **Start > All Programs > Administrative Tools > Component Services > Computer > My Computer**. Right-click **My Computer** and click **Properties**.
- 2. Click the **Default Properties** tab.
- 3. Check the **Enable Distributed COM on this computer** option.

- 4. Click OK, then click Start > All Programs > Administrative Tools > Internet Information Services (IIS) Manager.
- 5. Expand the **Sites -> Default Web Site** items.




FIGURE 2: INFORMATION SERVICES (IIS) MANAGER

- 6. Select **AFWeb** (Figure 2 below).




FIGURE 3: ENABLING ANONYMOUS AUTHENTICATION

7. Double-click **Authentication** and make sure **Anonymous Authentication** is enabled (Figure 3 below).

- 8. If you are using Microsoft Office 2007 on Windows 2008, make sure to create the following folder if it does not already exist (for details, click HERE):
  - For Windows 2008 32-bit: C:\Windows\System32\config\systemprofile\Desktop

- For Windows 2008 64-bit: C:\Windows\SysWOW64\config\systemprofile\Desktop.
