Introduction

In some cases, the SMTP Server (email server) is configured to send email on a port other than Port 25 (the default port). HMI Reports uses the default port number, but you can easily change the Port number to fit your requirements.

This Tech Note describes configuring HMI Reports to send email on a port other than 25 (default port).

Changing the SMTP Server Port Number

To use a designated Port

- 1. Open Report Designer.
- 2. Select a report from the List of Reports panel and right-click it.

- 3. Click Report Settings. The Report Settings window appears.
- 4. Click the Report File Format bar (Figure 2 below).

5. Check the **Email** option and click the **Settings** button. Configure your email in this window (Figure 3 below).

6. In the Mail server login information section, type the SMTP Server connection using the syntax shown in Figure 3 (above).

Use a colon character after your email server name, and before your port number. Do not include the angle brackets:

mail.<serverName>.net:<Port#>

- 7. Configure the remaining information specific to your server and credentials.
- 8. Click OK, and close the main Report Settings window.

You are now ready to send HMI Reports via your email server.
