Overview

The AutoSave suite of products provides you with the software tools needed to manage all your automation programs, tracking the changes to your industrial programmable devices and programs.

Augmenting the system's valuable 'standard' reports and logs, the AutoSave Reports Module allows users to generate a wide variety of reports from historical data stored in AutoSave's database.

The report's scope can further be defined employing user configurable options. Definable parameters can include date ranges, specific area, program, client, agent, bridge, wire, device, family, class, user, compare group, and more.


A report's specified options can be saved to run manually as needed or automatically upon a designated schedule including being part of a clustered sequential execution.

Initially, this module provides seventy-one (71) formatted, unique reports.

The reports are accessible using a computer's internet browser with AutoSave server network access; the computer need *not* be an AutoSave Client.

Within the categories, specific reports are available to provide a wide variety of reporting results.




Users and Groups
